# FASTVIEWER RECORD CONVERTER

Version 1.0.0



## Brief description

- The FastViewer Record Converter converts already recorded FastViewer sessions - including desktop sharing, audio and video to the format **\*.mp4**.
- These files can then be played with any MP4-player. Functions, e.g. fast-forward, rewind and cut etc., which were previously not available due to the revision-proof recording format can now be used.
- The revision-proof original file remains after the conversion, because the FastViewer Record Converter always creates a new file in the format **\*.mp4**.
- Both FastViewer sessions saved in the format **\*.fvwrec** and the format **\*.exe** can be converted with the FastViewer Record Converter.

## Technical requirements

- Supports Windows 7 up
- Increased rights required

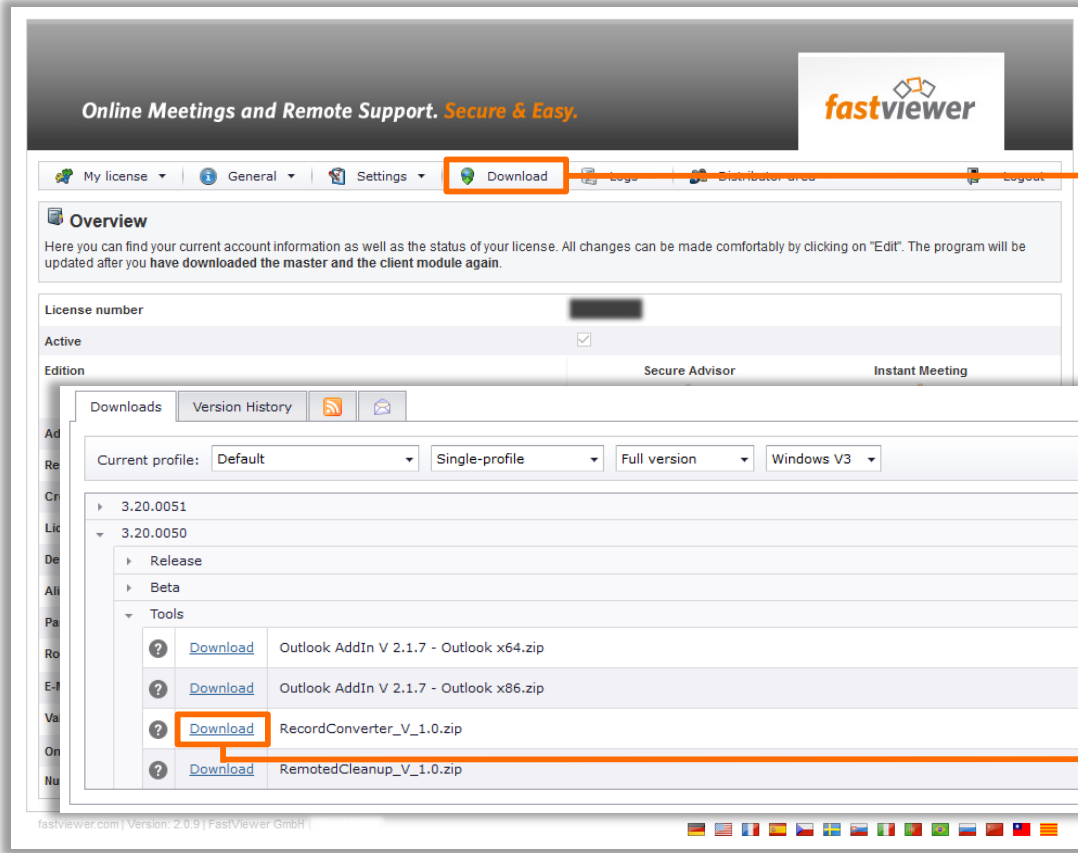

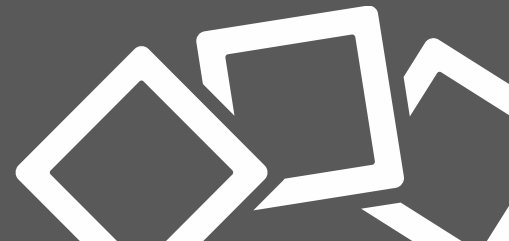
# Download of the Converter



Login to your personal FastViewer [customer portal](#).

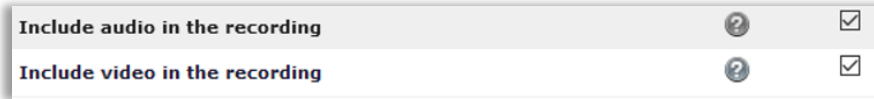
Click on the download tab to go to the download area of the modules.

Download the **RecordConverter** in **Tools**.




# Requirements

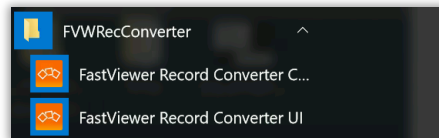
- In order to have audio and videos available in the recorded file formats **\*.fvwrec** and **\*.exe**, the modules must be configured accordingly in the FastViewer [customer portal](#).



- If you want to write in protected folders (e.g. /programs /subfolders), start the Converter with administrator rights.


## Installation of the FastViewer Record Converter

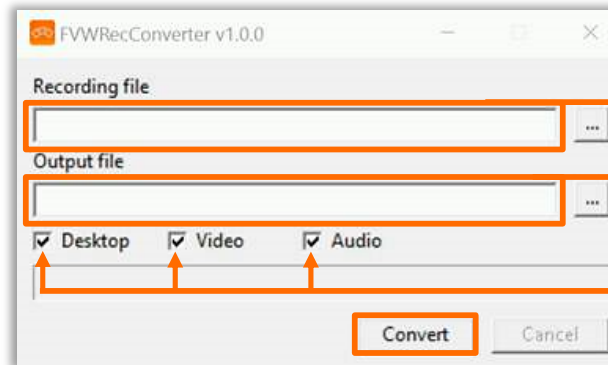
- After downloading run the file  **FVWRecConverterSetup.exe** and follow the installation wizard.
- Select a local destination path where the FastViewer Record Converter should be saved.
- After the installation, the Converter is in your start menu.



# Start and use of the Converter

If you have already recorded a FastViewer session, you can convert it directly to the format **\*.mp4** as follows. The original file is **not** lost after converting.

- Run  FastViewer Record Converter UI
- Define all parameters
- Klick *Convert*



Select the source file here, either by entering the path directly, or by clicking on **...** to browse the directories.

Select the destination file either by entering the path directly or by clicking on **...** to define destination path and filename.

Here, you select which components\* are to be transferred from the source file. The components with a checkmark set will be converted.  
\*All combinations possible – except „audio only“

When finished, the file is converted in the format **\*.mp4** and can be displayed with any kind of MP4-player.

## Command-line

Commandline Help:

Parameters of FVWRecConverter v1.0.0:
/help          Print help text.
/input:       Input file (*.fvwrec).
/output:      /optional Output file. By default the output file will be generated into the same directory as the converter tool.
/width:      /optional Video width. The default width is 1280.
/height:     /optional Video height. The default height is 720.
/video:      /optional Defines if the web cam video is included or not. Possible values: on, off. By default the video is included.
/audio:      /optional Defines if audio is included or not. Possible values: on, off. By default audio is included.
/screen:     /optional Defines if the screen capture is included or not. Possible values: on, off. By default the screen is included.
```

The FastViewer Record Converter can also be started directly from the console\*. Further functions are available.

Commandline:

```
C:\Program Files (x86)\FastViewer Record Converter>FVWRecConverter.exe /input:"C:\convert\input\01.fvwrec" /output:"C:\convert\output\01.mp4"
```
